

## DENTAL EXTRACTION CONSENT FORM

Many pets require additional extractions once he or she goes under anesthesia. As your veterinarian cleans the tartar off of each tooth underlying issues can be found such as abscesses, loose teeth, gum recession, etc. The condition of each tooth must be evaluated by your veterinarian before a decision is made as to the best course of treatment. Although no one likes surprises, it sometimes is impossible to give an accurate estimate before the day of your pet's dental procedure.
